This letter is to inform you that the Governor of Virginia has requested the Fort Monroe Board of Trustees to remove the Jefferson Davis Memorial Arch from the ramparts of the stone fort. Today, the Fort Monroe Board of Trustees voted to remove the Jefferson Davis Arch. Attached to this email is the Governor's letter and a letter from me, describing the urgency of everyone responding to show your dislike of the action taken today by the Board of Trustees.

At the end of the letter of explanation, I have included the names and contact information of all of the persons, who are connected in some way to Fort Monroe. These people are from these groups: General Assembly Members (House of Delegates and Senate), Fort Monroe Authority, Fort Monroe Board of Trustees, Fort Monroe Foundation, Casemate Museum, and the City of Hampton.
